Rotary Leadership Institute (RLI)  
Frequently Asked Questions**

**Is there a cost?**

Yes. The cost of RLI is \$50.00 (tbc) per person **for two days** which includes materials, room hire, and a light lunch each day.

For members who will serve as President of their club during 2021/22 or 2022/23 the cost will be funded by Rotary District 9810.

For all other participants the cost will be invoiced to your club, unless otherwise indicated on the registration form.

**What do the RLI training sessions look like? How long are they?**

Both sessions are on a Sunday with a 9.15am for 9.30am start.

A light lunch is provided and the session should be completed by 3.30pm

The facilitated sessions mean that all participants learn from others in the room, so as a representative of your club, you can contribute to the shared knowledge and you will find out how other clubs tackle some of the challenges your club may be facing. At a recent training, one of the participants commented that in the 20+ years of Rotary enjoyment, they had learned more in the RLI sessions than in all their years of service.
