## ROTARY DISTRICT 9810 FORM YOUTH PROTECTION RISK ASSESSMENT

The following information shall be provided to the District Insurance Officer and the District Club Protection Co-ordinator prior to the commencement of any youth program or project.

- 1. Describe the activity / project being undertaken.
- 2. Detail the people participating in the activity / project. Does it involve young people and other members of the public who are non-Rotarians? Does it involve other organizations?
- 3. If it involves young people, have you confirmed that all persons involved in the activity / project have been screened for suitability via:
  - a. Confirmation of a current Working With Children Check (WWCC).
  - b. Declaration of criminal record.
  - c. Reference checks.

4. Describe the potential hazards or dangers to the general public and to persons participating in the activity / project.

- 5. Have there been prior incidents or accidents on this type of project and, if so, what occurred and what action has been taken to reduce the risk of a repeat of the incident or accident?
- 6. What action can be taken to:
  - Remove or eliminate hazards
  - Isolate the source of hazards or danger
  - Reduce the likelihood of an incident occurring
  - Reduce the seriousness of an incident if it does occur?
- 7. If working with another organization, have you ensured that the other organization has its own Public Liability Insurance. Ensure that you obtain a copy of the Certificate of Currency of that Insurance.
- 8. Have you ensured that you have not been requested by any other organization to indemnify them as a Third Party? Under no circumstance do so without clearance from the 9810 District Insurance Officer.
